

An Open Letter to the Half Moon Bay Pickleball Community,

I write today on behalf of the staff and Board of Boys and Girls Club of the Coastside (BGCC). We know there is tremendous interest in using the Cunha tennis courts for pickleball. We tasked a committee to explore BGCC managing such an endeavor and decided it was more than we can manage at this moment. However, we are not simply walking away. We offer two resources for you.

- 1) The City of Half Moon Bay Parks and Recreation Department has rented the courts each Sunday and opens them for public use from noon to 4 PM. Please tell your friends and family and come out and play during these hours. (And if you want more hours, especially during the summer, let the City staff know.)
- 2) If you'd like to rent the courts directly here is a path forward to making this a reality. Our staff can be a resource for you.
 - a) Form an association.
 - i) This would require leadership and bylaws.
 - b) Purchase insurance. We have sourced two vendors who would be willing to sell insurance to a pickleball association
 - i) Great American Insurance Group -513-369-5000
 - ii) Joe Angelini Farmer's Insurance 650-726-4818
 - c) Have the association rent the courts from CUSD. The association would then take responsibility for managing who was on the courts and when.
 - d) Currently there are 2 courts available for rental and the cost is \$25 per hour, per court.
